


## GHSA GIRLS AND CO-ED 3-POINT SHOOTING CONTEST PRELIMINARY ROUND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Participants must complete and sign the event waiver form prior to the competition.
- 2. The competition will consist of (2) rounds.
- 3. The competition shooting order for the 1<sup>st</sup> round will be determined by a blind draw.
- 4. The shooting order for the elimination round will be determined by the point total in the 1<sup>st</sup> round, from the lowest to the highest scores determining the shooting order.
- 5. The top three scores from the elimination round will advance to the semifinal round of competition.
- 6. Each of the two rounds will be 90-seconds, with six balls at each of the four locations (see illustration below).
- 7. Each of the first five balls in each rack counts as one point, with the final ball in each rack counting as three points.
- 8. In the Co-Ed competition, both participants must be from the same school. The girl shall select two of the shooting spots and the boy shall shoot from the other two spots. They may choose any order of the 4-spots but, shall alternate shooting the entire rack of balls before their teammate shoots.
- 9. In the event of a tie, the 1<sup>st</sup> tie-breaker is the total score from both rounds. The 2<sup>nd</sup> tie-breaker is a shoot-off at the free throw line (alternating attempts until one successful shooter is left).



## GHSA GIRLS AND CO-ED 3-POINT SHOOTING CONTEST SEMIFINAL ROUND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Participants must complete and sign the event waiver form prior to the competition.
- 2. The competition will consist of (2) rounds. NOTE: Same timing protocol as preliminary round.
- 3. The competition shooting order for the 1<sup>st</sup> round will be determined by a blind draw.
- 4. The shooting order for the elimination round will be determined by the point total in the 1<sup>st</sup> round, from the lowest to the highest scores determining the shooting order.
- 5. In the event of a tie, the 1<sup>st</sup> tie-breaker is the total score from both rounds. The 2<sup>nd</sup> tie-breaker is a shoot-off at the free throw line (alternating attempts until one successful shooter is left).
- 6. The top scorer from each semifinal site will advance to the Championship Finals at the Macon Coliseum. CO-FINALS on Thursday, March 6, 2025 and GIRLS FINALS on Friday, March 7, 2025.
