The impact of Hurricane Helene closed out September with hundreds of game changes (football, softball, volleyball, cross country, and cheerleading competitions) including postponements and cancellations from our GHSA member schools. Executive Director, Tim Scott, spoke with WSB-TV out of Atlanta about the changes made the week of September 23rd.

On October 1st, due to the severe damage in several areas of the State, the GHSA decided to change the original football playoff schedule by adding a week to the regular season. Our thoughts




- Officials' appreciation week banners and signage on the fence, wall, etc., surrounding the contest playing area.

Former NFL Player Returns to GHSA to Coach



The Northside - Warner Robins football game is one of the biggest rivalries in the state, originating in 1964. On the north side of Warner Robins, there's a familiar face on the sidelines that was once a dominant force in uniform. Fifteen years ago Abry Jones was an Under Armor All-American helping push the Eagles dynasty to higher heights. After graduation, Jones went to Georgia and had an amazing playing career between the hedges, which earned him a chance to play in the NFL for nearly ten seasons. Now retired at 32, the 6-foot-4 former NFL lineman is back coaching at his alma

mater. "It's the closest thing you can get to the Super Bowl in high school", says Jones. "I mean the whole town is behind it, everyone is talking about it. You walk around the city and people ask you

what are you going to do on Friday night? It's the first time you become a mini-celebrity in the city so I loved it." Jones is helping coach the defensive line as a community coach, under second-year head coach Ben Bailey.

Warner Robins won the contest, 34-12 to extend their streak to 8 wins in a row. Jones, however was undefeated in the series as a player, going 4-0 from 2005-2008.
