- TWO FOLLOWSPOTS LOCATED IN THE THEATRE'S REAR AT THE BOOTH LEVEL.
- TELEX COMMUNICATION (WIRED) IS LOCATED IN EACH WING, AT THE FOLLOWSPOTS AND IN THE CONTROL BOOTH FOR LIGHTBOARD, SOUNDBOARD AND STAGE MANAGER
- TO LOAD SCENERY, A LOADING DOCK IS LOCATED AT THE REAR OF THE MABRY ARTS CENTER (SEE MAP). THE LOADING DOCK IS 30" HIGH AND LOADS DIRECTLY INTO THE SCENE SHOP VIA A 9' WIDE BY 10' TALL ROLL DOOR.

- STAGE ACCESS IS STAGE RIGHT AND FROM THE SCENE SHOP VIA A 9' WIDE BY 10' HIGH ROLL DOOR
- GENERAL CHORAL MICS ARE SET FOR SOUND REINFORCEMENT.
- CD's MAY BE PLAYED FROM THE BOOTH AS REQUIRED USING OUR EQUIPMENT
- A LAPTOP MAY BE PATCHED INTO THE SOUND SYSTEM USING AN AUX CORD PROVIDED
- WE WILL BE USING TWO SETS OF DRESSING ROOMS ADJACENT TO THE STAGE ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE FORTHCOMING
