Dressing Rooms

9 Standard Lighting Areas

Full Wash

Two Follow Spots - Back corners of the house

Red, Green, Blue CYC

Warm Wash

Cool Wash

<u>Sound</u>

(1) One auxiliary cable will be available at the sound booth for audio. You must supply the device and control the level.

If you are using any type of microphone system, you must bring your own sound system.

If you are doing a musical and are using mics, you must supply your own sound equipment and sound manager.

Cell Phones

We will have strict cell phone policy during performances. Please remind students to turn off cell phones during ALL performances.

Food and Drink Policy

Food and drinks **will not** be allowed inside the theater. NO EXCEPTIONS. Sealed water bottles are the only exception. Food/drinks will need to be consumed outside of the theater. Please communicate this to your students and boosters.

Unauthorized Locations

Please make sure your students and parents are supervised at all times. Students and/or parents who are found in unauthorized locations will be asked to leave the campus and will not be allowed to return.

<u>Load-In</u>

The loading dock is located at the back of the fine arts wing of the building. It is a shared loading dock with band, engineering and theater. It is a ground level loading dock.

The loading dock door is 10' tall and 10' wide.

You will have to pass through a hallway that is 12' wide and 10' tall

The load-in door to the stage is 10' wide and 12' tall.

Please keep to the schedule. If you have larger pieces that need to be assembled, please prepare to do those outside before your assigned load-in time (weather permitting). No assembly can happen in the scene shop while other shows are performing. Please prepare to do any assembly outside or during your 15 minute walk-though.

Load-out

As soon as you are finished with your show, you <u>MUST</u> load-out directly to your truck.

Stage Measurements

Proscenium width is 40' 7"

Apron to main curtain is 8'

Apron to mid traveler is 17'

Apron to upstage traveler is 36'

Apron to cyc is 37'

Wings are approx. 12' by 36' on each side.

Line Placement

Side lines will be just inside the proscenium roughly 40' from side-to-side

Apron to mid-go-line is 17' at the mid traveler

Apron to back-go-line is 28'

Backline to upstage traveler is 8'

Backline to cyc is 9'

Electrical Outlets

Each wing has 3 evenly spaced power outlets.

Upstage behind the cyc has 2 power outlets

The apron (audience level) has four power outlets

Back of the house has 4 power outlets.

Additional Denmark HS Theatre Rules

No painting may be done in the building or anywhere on the property.

Helium balloons are not allowed in the building.

No live flame will be allowed on stage.

Atmospherics will not be allowed during this event. This includes, smoke machines, fog machines, dry-ice fog machines and hazers. No exceptions. Please do not ask.
